The 19th NASTEC (Nordic Atomic Spectroscopy and Trace Element Conference) will be held at the Edda Hotel, Laugarvatn, Iceland from Monday June 25th (Registration) to Friday June 29th, Anno Domini 2007.

The scope of the NASTEC is trace element analysis, using atomic spectroscopy or other measurement techniques.

The program will include keynote lectures, by invited speakers, as well as shorter oral presentations and poster presentations by the participants. We invite people to present their work on one or more of the following topics:

- Sample introduction
- Novel measurement techniques
- Speciation
- Miniaturization
- Hyphenations

Papers on other aspects of trace element analysis and atomic spectroscopy are also welcomed.
